Dion Horstmans' practice investigates architectural and spatial concerns through line, form, perception, and volume. With Voltage, Horstmans continues to explore the dynamic movement of various astronomical phenomena. This time he narrows his focus to contain the forms and energy of lightning within his steel structures.

Horstmans has held a number of highly successful solo exhibitions at FLG, including Laws of Motion (2010), Light Speed (2011), and 2012's The Dark Side, which investigated lunar themes. He participated in the 2012 Vivid Festival, and SxS, Bondi's International Sculpture Exhibition, as well as its sister events in Cottesloe and Aarhus, Denmark.






Rolling Thunder 2013 Powdercoated steel 140 x 91 x 48cm




