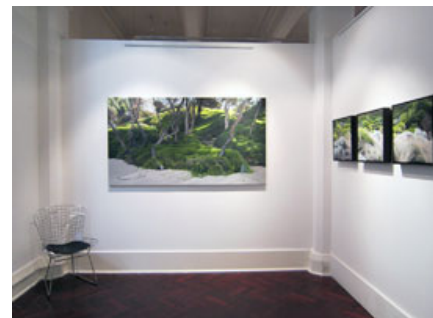

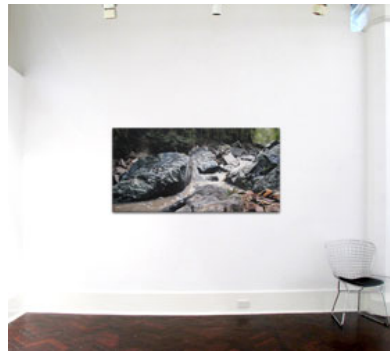

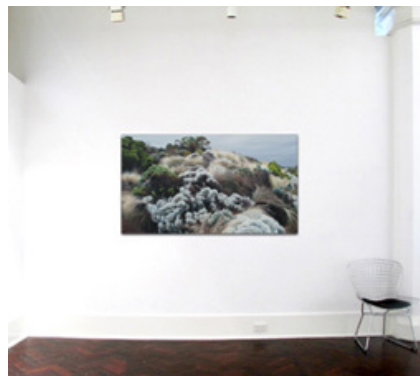

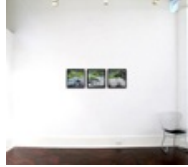

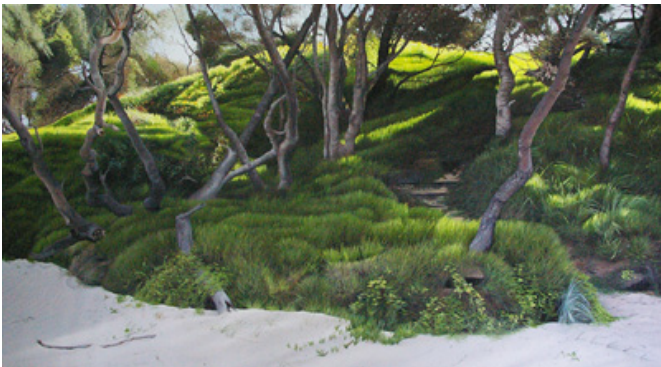

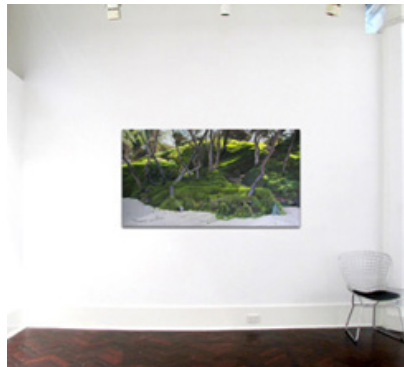
Wild Arms

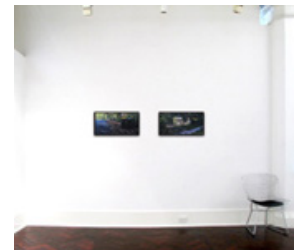
